## Church

1. Praise God the covid-19 restrictions in Victoria have been relaxed. Many of us are looking forward to returning to church. Provided there will be no new local outbreak, indoor religious gatherings will be allowed up to 50 people from 23 November. However, due to the density rule of 1 person per 4m<sup>2</sup> limit, even with this further relaxation, the church chapel's seating capacity will only be around 40 people. Hence, we are planning to live stream our worship and service from church instead. Let's pray for a smooth and safe transition and the set-up of live streaming equipment. We will keep you posted with more information later.
