In Sam Chan's recent book, "How to Talk about Jesus – Without Being *That* Guy!", Sam says this: "We want to tell our friends about Jesus. We're told that we need to tell our friends about Jesus. But we don't know how to do it. When it comes to evangelism, we are scared and helpless."

This is very consistent with answers to a question that I asked in face-to-face seminars in every state capital city around Australia (except Hobart and Darwin). The question was:

"Why isn't sharing our faith 'second nature' to us - why doesn't it come naturally?

The answer was the same in every state Capital City:

"We're afraid, and we don't know what to say".

The series is NOT a traditional course in evangelism. The four sessions have been designed to encourage you to share your faith, overcome fear and have something to say.
