- Pray for all those affected by the tragedy at Bondi Beach. May God bring comfort to grieving families, healing to the injured, and peace to all who are mourning. Pray that our community will come together in compassion and strength, and that God's love will shine through even in this time of sorrow.

## **Pray for C&MA and our International Worker**

- Pray for the Ooi family serving in Japan that they can balance study, ministry, church commitments, and family life. May God guide and sustain them each day. Pray for God's grace in Japanese language learning and deeper relationships with the people there.
