1. Praise God for His provision of the new properties (Livingstone House, Rentoul Hall and the Community Garden). We are inviting brothers and sisters to participate in a Signage Design Competition for these new properties. The competition will run from 2 August to 27 September 2026. Please submit your design along with the registration document to victorccccheung@gmail.com. For any enquiries, please contact Deacon Victor Cheung.

Signage Design Requirements:

- i. The design must reflect the meaning of the building's name and be consistent with biblical principles.
 - ii. The signage size for Livingstone House and Rentoul Hall must not exceed 100cm in width and 30cm in height (or a total surface area of 3000cm²). The signage size for the Community Garden must not exceed 70cm in width and 100cm in height (or a total surface area of 7000cm²).
 - iii. All signage must clearly display both English and Chinese names.
 - iv. All designs must be suitable for wall mounting or secure installation. The materials used should be durable and suitable for outdoor use.
 - v. All submissions will first be voted on by the Combined Board before being presented to the congregation for voting.
 - vi. An implementation plan and estimated material costs must be provided.
 - vii. No physical model is required; please submit the design drawing only.
2. For accommodation and itinerary arrangements, 2027 Cambodia Mission Trip enrollment deadline will be 31 August.
 3. Starting in the second half of the year, the church's gardening team will hold a Working Bee on the first Sunday afternoon of each month to help maintain our Community Garden.

Our next Working Bee will be held at 2:00pm today, and will be our second session. Everyone is warmly invited to join! Whether you can stay for a long time or just a few minutes, even just pulling a weed is a meaningful way to support the garden and serve our neighbours.
